<sup>1</sup> By Arizona law, corporations, unions and PACs are not limited in what they may give to a statewide initiative campaign, either promoting or opposing a particular ballot measure. By Federal and state law, 501(C)(3) and 501(C)(4) organizations, including faith-based institutions, may encourage voters to support or oppose a ballot measure, and *may contribute financially to initiative campaigns*. These contributions count as "lobbying expenses" for the nonprofit, which in total, cannot exceed 20% of the non-profit's annual operating budget. Those having elected 501(H) status can contribute more. Please consult your accountant or tax advisor for further guidance.
